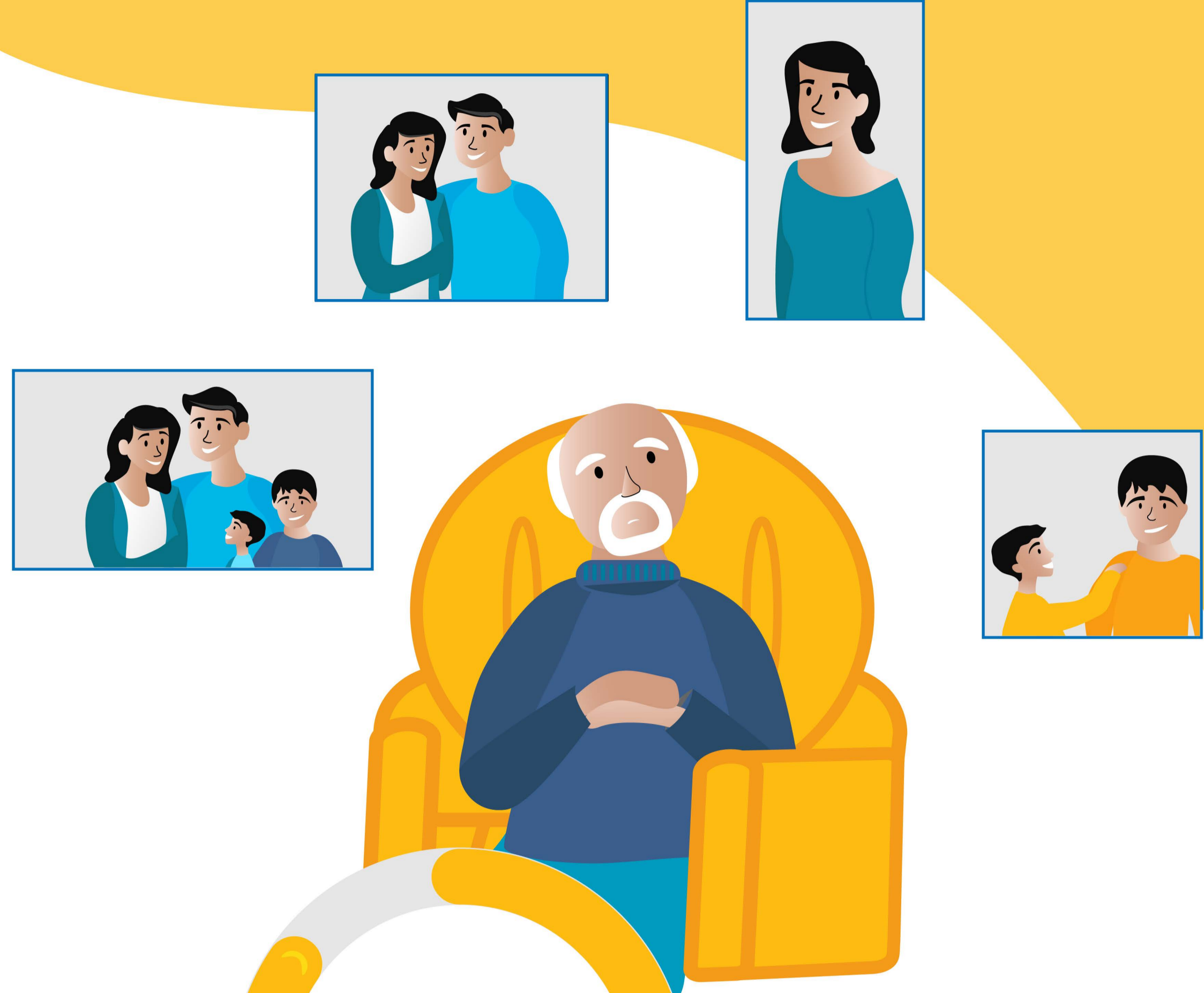
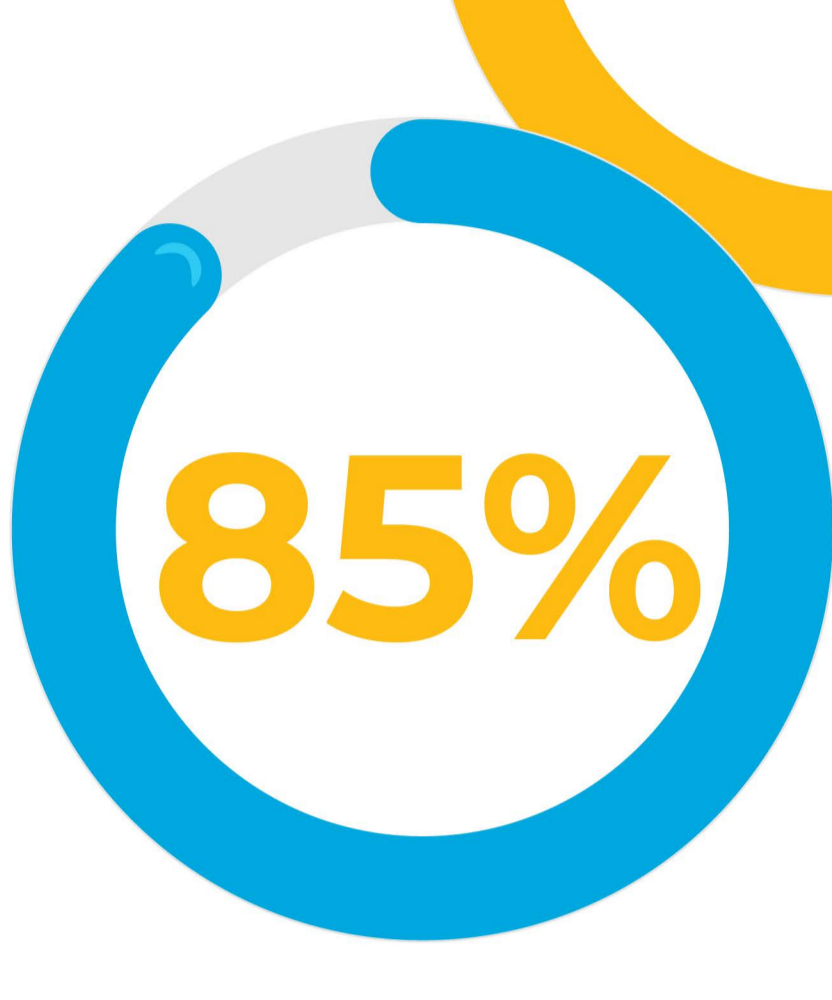


Older Adult Mental Health & Coping During COVID-19

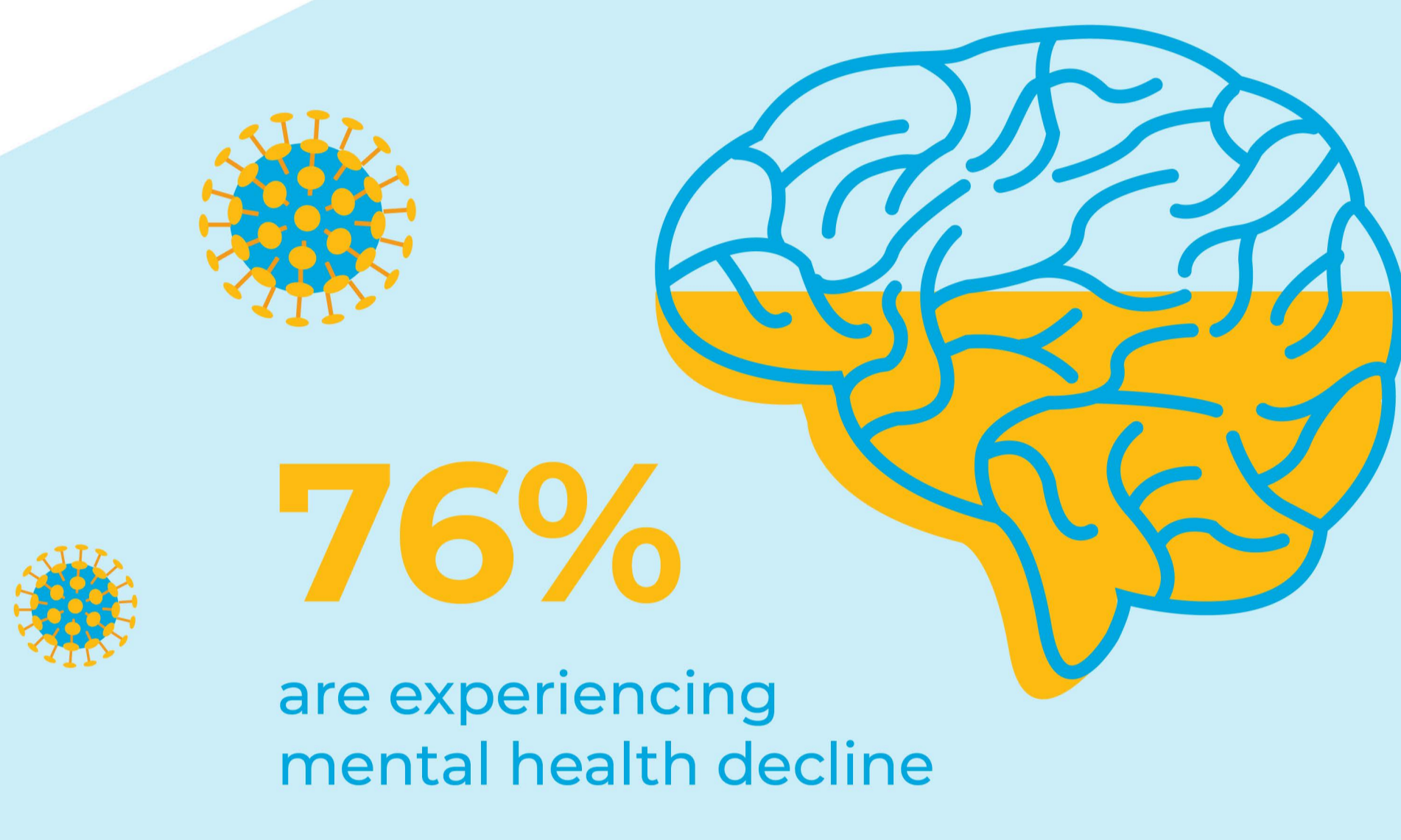
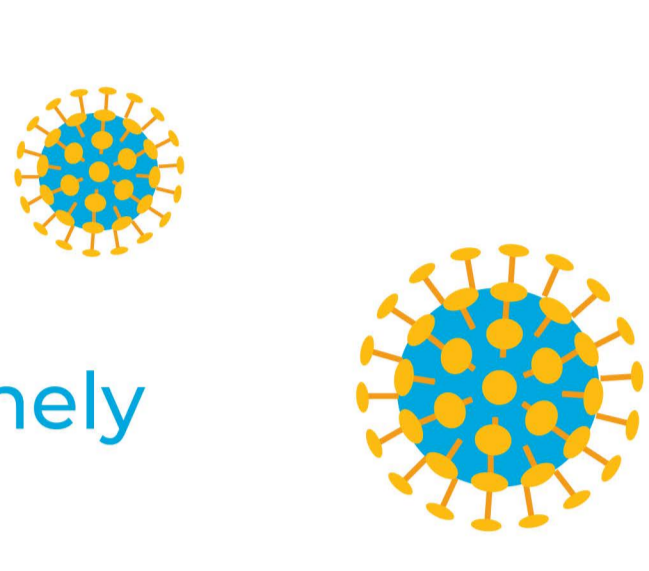
A nationwide survey of 1,000 American adults with an older adult parent (over 70) who lives alone found that during COVID-19:



are more isolated from loved ones



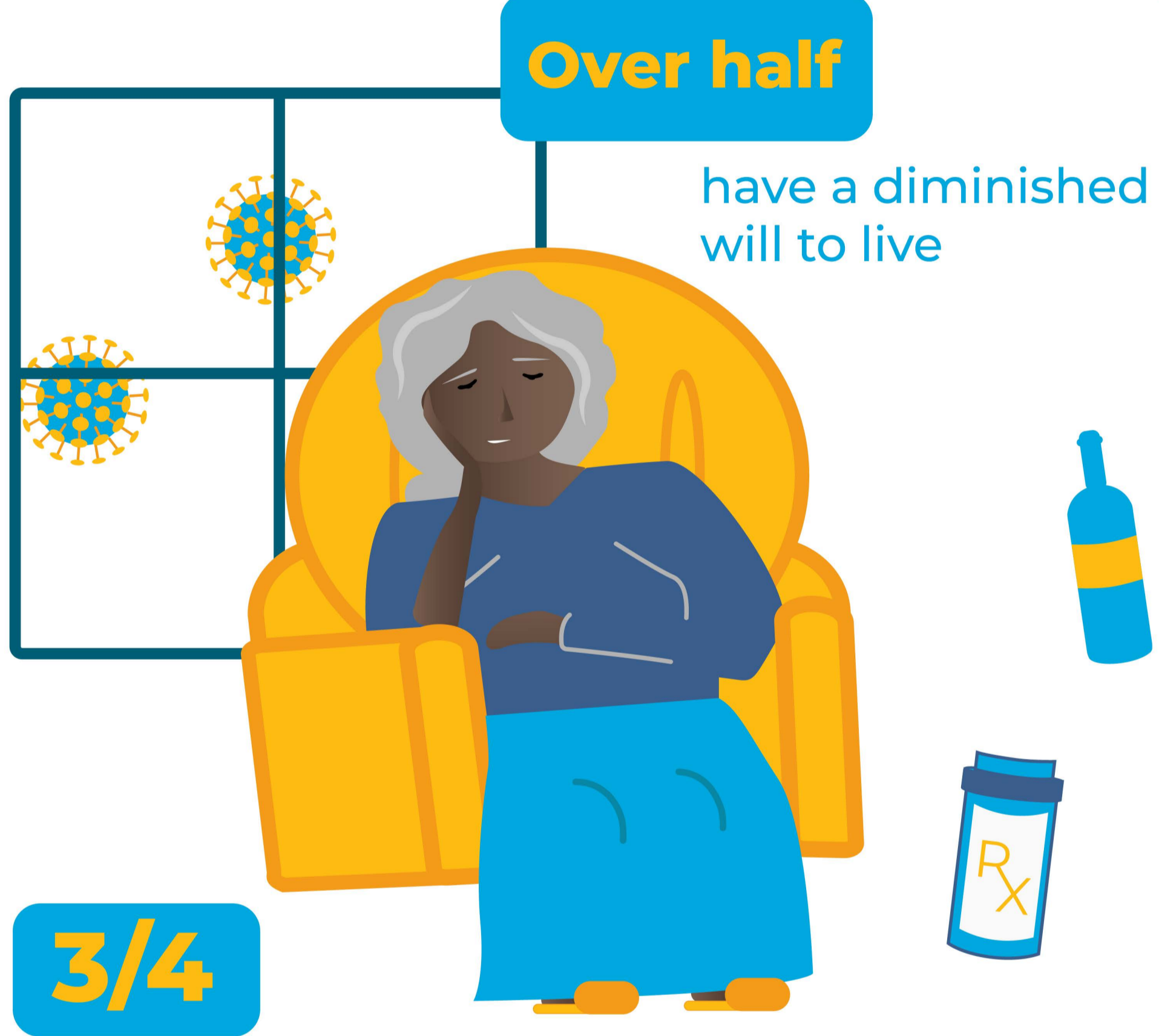
are more lonely

are at increased risk for suicide



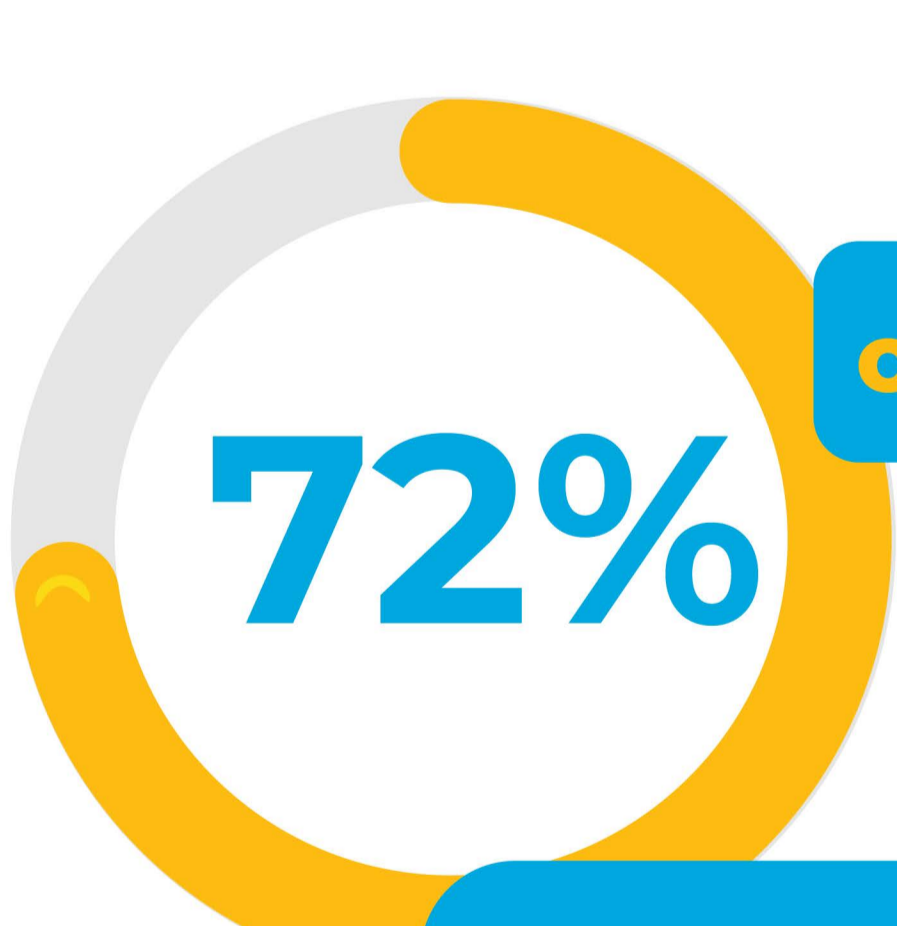
Over half

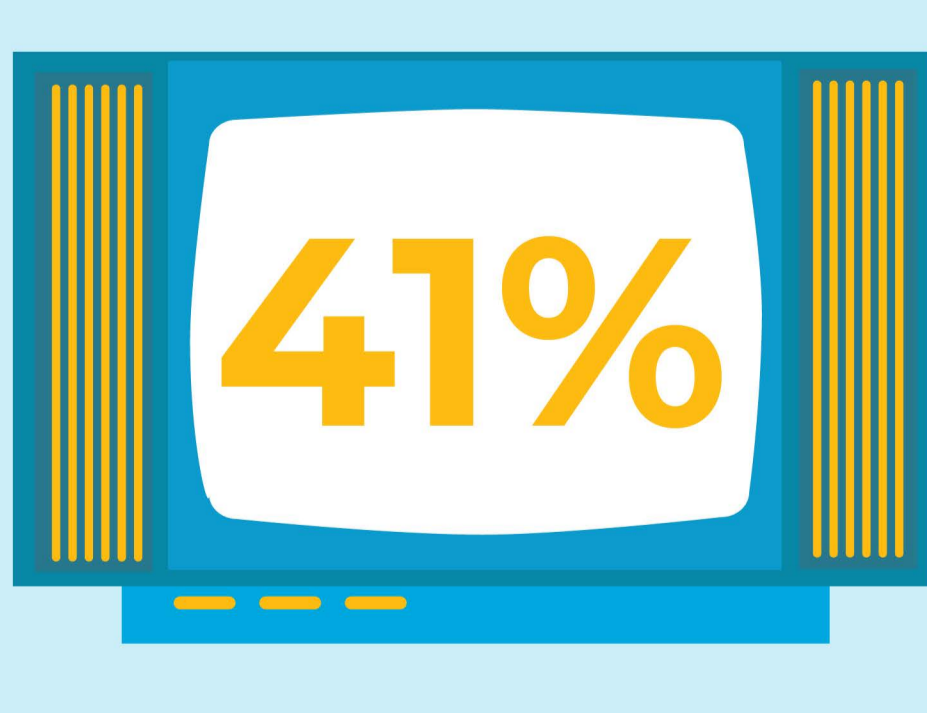
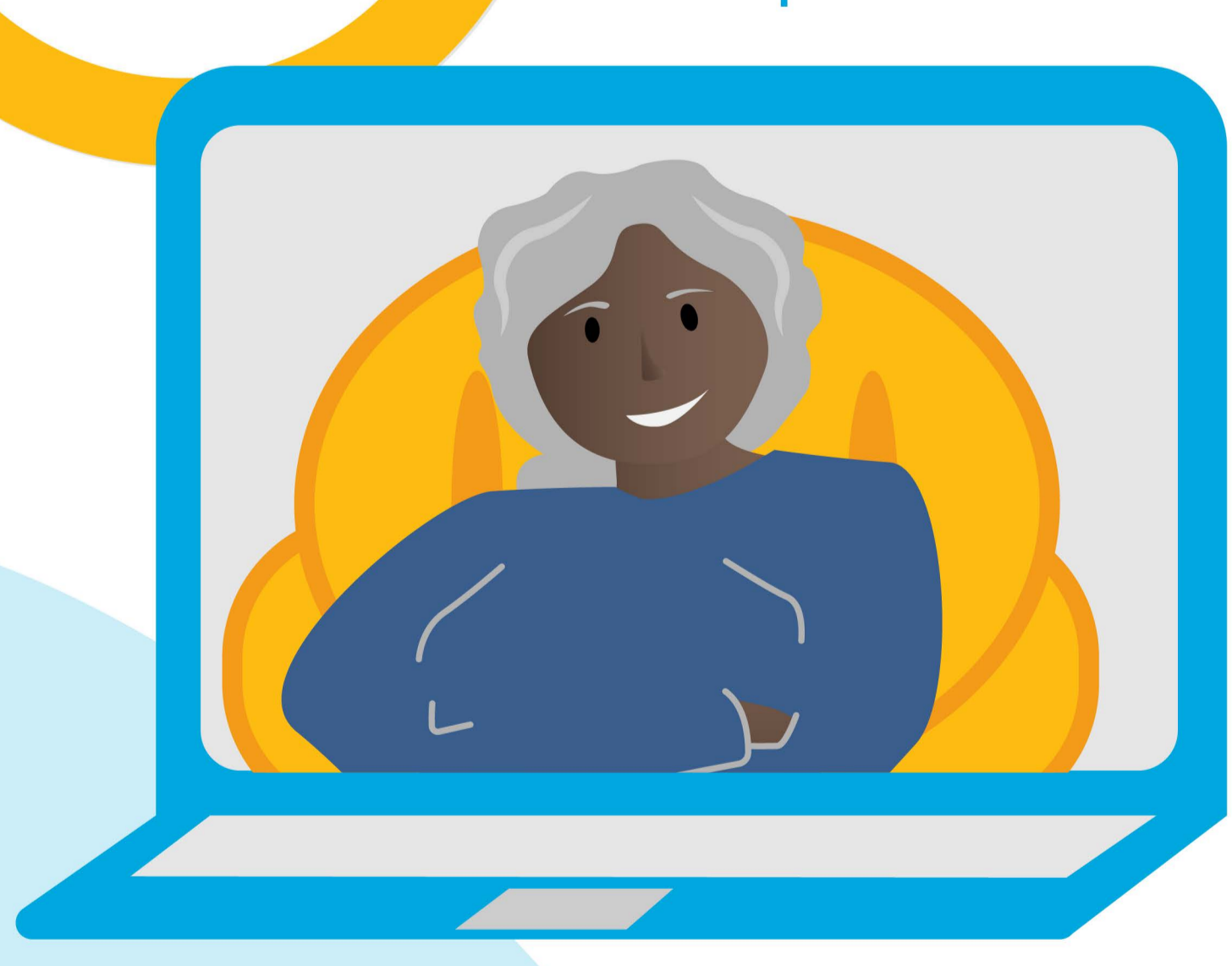
